## Questions & Answers

Q How will the zones be governed?

A Zones will see little change in the way they are governed. A governance agreement will replace the bylaws.

Q Will the governance agreement state the actions allowed by a zone?

A Yes, the governance agreement will be used as a guideline, the same way bylaws are used as guidelines.

Q Will zones still be represented on the NAAA Board of Directors?

A Yes, the current process does not change.

Q Will zones still present nominees for NAAA officers?

A Yes, the current process does not change.

Q Will the '3 strike rule' still apply?

A Yes; the '3 strike rule' will not change, except it will now be administered by NAAA.

Q At what meeting(s) will attendance be taken?

A Attendance will be taken at both the spring business meeting and the national conference.

Q Who will collect zone dues?

A Dues will be collected by the staff at NAAA headquarters.  
Zone dues and NAAA dues will be on one invoice.

Q How will the zone funds be held and who will direct the spending of those funds?

A The process will not change and zones determine how funds are used.

Q What can the zones expect from the NAAA headquarters?

A NAAA headquarters staff will:

1. Record minutes and attendance at all meetings.
2. Provide financial reports at annual meetings and when requested.
3. Provide membership and 'three strike rule' reports.
4. Invest funds at request of zone.
5. Produce semiannual bound reports including all the above.
